

Agenda Item No. 3:- Discontinuation of Participation in Subroto Cup Football Tournament.

- As per Subroto Mukerjee Sports Education Society (SMSES) letter point no.-3 "A skeletal age determination test of all the players at the venue if four (04) or more players are found to be overage from a team then the team will be disqualified from taking any part in the tournament".
- All participating Schools have to register their players individually through the online portal at the Subroto Mukerjee Sports Education Society with an entry fee of Rs. 2000/- per School/Team.
- If KVS (U-14 & 17 Boys, U-17 Girls) participates in 63rd Subroto Cup Football Tournament, 2024, then KVS will have to go for **Skeletal Age Determination Test** of all selected student and registration of each player through SMSES portal at Vidyalaya level before participation in Pre-Subroto Regional Football Tournament because winner school of KVS National Pre-Subroto Cup Football team (U-14 & 17 Boys, U-17 Girls) are eligible to participates in Subroto Cup International Football Tournament.
- The additional finance burden will come, if the same number of teams/students will take part in KVS Regional Pre-Subroto Cup Tournament, 2024 to select KVS National (Winner teams of U-14 & 17 Boys and U-17 Girls) teams before participation in 63rd Subroto Cup Football Tournament, 2024-25.

- Non-availability of facilities (Authorized / Certified Labs) for the **Skeletal age determination test** at the station.
- Concerned KV or Parents will have to pay fees @ **Rs.1040/- (Approx.)** for said test towards selected students (16 players in each team).
- Registration fees @ **Rs.2000/-** has to be borne by the concerned Vidyalaya from VVN.
- Parents concerned may not be agreed for this test and payment of fees.

Discussed on above specific issues / problems and approval has been accorded for discontinuation of organization of Pre-Subroto Cup Football at KVS level and participation of KVS teams in Subroto Cup Football Tournament from this Session-2024-25.

Agenda Item No. 6:- Target to enhance KVS performance in 68th NSG (SGFI) 2024-25 under "Mission-SGFI 100+ Medals".

Discussed to enhance the performance of KVS in SGFI Championship. All Regions/Vidyalaya will set their target and put more efforts to provide better Sports Facilities, Coaches and Training to children at Vidyalaya / Regional level by utilizing VVN/ RSCB/ PM SHRI Fund to get 100+ Medals in SGFI. The details of KVS performance in 67th NSG(SGFI) 2023-24:-

Decision: Approved.

Agenda Item No.7:- Enhancement of DA of Students (Last enhanced in 2018-19).

Discussed at length on enhancement of DA and suggested to take up on file separately.

- DA of Students shall be enhanced from the Session 2024-25 onwards for conducting KVS Sub-Regional, Regional & National/SGFI and other level activities as given below;
- DA Rs. 650/- per head per day (Full Meal + Accommodation + Bedroll + Cot) if stay venue at KVs.
- DA Rs. 600/- per head per day (Full Meal + Accommodation + Bedroll + Cot) if stay venue at Outsource.
- In case of Journey (Rate Per head per day) periods -
- More than 08 hours Rs. 500/- only.
- Less than 08 hours Rs. 300/- only.
- If not staying overnight & not availing (Dinner) lodging facilities Rs. 400/- only.

Decision: Noted & recommended to be examined DA on file by finance wing and recommended to fix a ceiling of expenditure at National level i.e. Shamyanas & Tent, Decoration, Cultural Programme for Opening & Closing Ceremony, Photography & Videography, Decorative Light & PA System. Further, the National venue has to send estimates to KVS (HQ) through RO for vetting.

Agenda Item No. 8:- Enhancement of Annual Subscription for KVS Sports Portal from Regions.

No discussion was made on this issue.

Decision: Suggested to take up on file separately.

Agenda Item No. 9:- Utilization of available Sports infrastructure and it's maintenance at RO/KV level.

Discussed and suggested that the existing Sports infrastructure/facilities will be used by the Students, Staff of KV for promotion of Sports before, during and after school hours and available Sports Infrastructure/facilities shall be maintained properly by the concerned Vidyalaya / Regional from their VVN/ RSCB fund regularly.

Decision: Approved.

Agenda Item No. 10:- Review of KVS Sports Hostels (SLKIC) joint venture with SAI under Khelo India Scheme.

The following four KVs are having Sports hostel.

- KVNo.1, Delhi Cant. (Delhi Region) of Archery & Judo for Girls
- KV No. 1, Gwalior Cantt. (Bhopal Region) of Athletics & Shooting for Girls.

- KV Sidhi (Jabalpur Region) Archery & Boxing for Boys.

Agenda Item No. 11:- Status of Para Sports of children with Special Needs (CWSN) in Hyderabad as Pilot Project.

Discussed and taken view from the Deputy Commissioner of Hyderabad Region.

Decision: Suggested to take up on file separately.

Agenda Item No. 12:- Training / Seminar / Workshop / Short duration Sports Clinic Programme for TGT(P&HE) & Member of Regional Sports Cell.

Discussed and suggested to connect/join TGT(P&HE) with NCERT Programme also.

- 1-2 Days Training programs will be designed at Regional level for TGT(P&HE) updating Sports portal, Sports rules & regulation of Sports, latest trends of Sports & Games through online under guidance of Regional Sports Cell.
- 1-2 Days Work shop/ clinic will be planned for all members of Regional Sports Cell to enhance the knowledge of Sports Portal, Sports Management and organization of Sports Events by National Sports Cell, HQ.

Decision: Approved.

Agenda Item No. 13:- Strengthening of School Sports Department & Regional Sports Cell in all Regions.

To providing proper set up for School Sports Department / Regional Sports Cell (i.e. Separate Room, Computer set, Printer, Internet connection etc).

Discussed that the requirement of proper space, electronics devices & equipment are very essential for smooth working of School Sports Department & Regional Sports Cell at ROs.

Decision: Approved.

Agenda Item No. 14:- Status of NSCB Account & RSCB Account.

Discussed on Preparation of Sports Budget for current academic session by all KVs/ROs on the basis of previous years' expenditure and availability of fund / income.

Decision: Noted.

Agenda Item No. 15:- Any other points with permission of the Chair.


The following important points were raised and discussed in house -

- (i) Sports Playing Kit (T-Shirt, Shorts, Track suits, Shoes & Socks) will not be taken back from students once issued to them.
- (ii) Criteria for exemption from deputation of female teachers having child below five (05) years should be reduced from 05 to 02 years from this session (Suggested by Patna Region).
- (iii) Sports and Games Period/class should not be utilized for any subject teaching class during school hours.
- (iv) No proposal will be accepted at KVS(HQ) for the approval of Leveling & filling soil / cutting of grass / bushes & trees or cleaning of Playground/field.
- (v) Expenditures of TA & DA may be incurred on pro-rata basis from VVN of concerned KV during Sub-Regional & Regional level Sports if sufficient fund are not available in RSCB Fund.
- (vi) Development of Sports Infrastructures in KV for Individuals Sports i.e. Archery, Athletics, Boxing, Judo, Taekwondo, Shooting, Chess from VVN/RSCB/NSCB fund.

Decision: Point (i), (iii), (iv), (v) & (vi) are approved and (ii) not approved.
